

The winner of the Kolej Technologies, Inc. (“Kolej”) x Canada International Royal Arts College Inc. (“CIRA College”) scholarship contest must meet the following admission requirements for the Media Design & Web Development Program (“Program”):

1. The winner/student must gather all of the following required documents:
 - a. Official high school transcript or equivalent;
 - b. English language proficiency from one of the following;
 - i. IELTS: 5.5
 - ii. TOEIC: 620
 - iii. TOEFL: PTB – 513; CTB – 183; iBT – 65
 - iv. English 12: a minimum final grade of 60%
 - v. CIRA College placement test – 70%
 - c. A passport that is valid (not expired) from September 2023 to September 2025 (this is a minimum requirement); and
 - d. Be 18 years of age as of January 1, 2023.
2. The winner/student must submit their application with all required documents online to CIRA College (www.ciracollege.com).
3. Letter of Acceptance
 - a. If the winner/student is a successful candidate, the Admissions Team at CIRA College will issue you an official letter of acceptance which you will use to apply for your study permit at Immigration, Refugees and Citizenship Canada (“IRCC”).
4. Start Studying
 - a. After the winner/student’s study permit has been issued by IRCC and the confirmation of the issuance of the study permit has been forwarded by the winner/student to the Admissions Team at CIRA College, the winner/student can purchase their plane ticket and start to study in Canada!

Other Terms & Conditions:

The release of the scholarship funds by Kolej to CIRA college is contingent upon the winner/student successfully meeting the above listed requirements.

The scholarship funds will be paid directly by Kolej to CIRA College and will be directly applied to the winner/student’s tuition fees only.

The scholarship funds will cover the tuition fees of the Program, the CIRA College application fee, and any required course materials.

The scholarship funds cannot and will not be applied to any other fees, including but not limited to, housing and accommodation for the student, meals for the student, airline tickets to, from and within Canada for the student, the student’s IRCC application fee, or computers, laptops, or other similar devices for the personal use of the student.

If for any reason the winner/student decides to withdraw from the Program after the Program start date, the winner/student will not be entitled to any cash value of the scholarship funds and the scholarship funds will be returned to Kolej.

If the winner/student decides to withdraw from the Program before the Program start date, the winner/student is not entitled to any cash value of the scholarship funds and the scholarship funds will be returned to Kolej.

If the winner/student receives a refusal letter from IRCC, rejecting their study permit application, the winner is not entitled to any cash value of the scholarship funds, nor will the student be entitled to any compensation for any reason from Kolej or CIRA College.

The anticipated Program start date is September 11, 2023.

The anticipated Program end date is August 31, 2025.

If for any reason the Program does not start on September 11, 2023, every effort will be made to communicate this to the winner/student and the scholarship funds will be held by Kolej and will be paid by Kolej to CIRA College upon the new start date.
